## Evening Programme in Granica – Kampinos National Park

After a full day of activities, guests are warmly invited to continue the evening in **Granica**, in the heart of **Kampinos National Park**.

**17:00 - 18:00** – Arrival at the recreational meadow in Granica

**18:00 - 18:45** – Welcome break with a hot meal, time to relax, use the facilities, and enjoy the surroundings

**18:45 - 19:45** – Optional walk and visit

For those who wish, we offer a short walk along the educational nature trail *Skrajem Puszczy* (“At the Edge of the Forest”), via a viewing point, to two historic interwar buildings:

- the **Open-Air Museum of Forest Architecture**
- the **Kampinos Forest Museum**

These sites introduce the history of the forest, forestry, the people who lived and worked in the forest, local fauna and flora, and the story of the creation of Kampinos National Park.

**20:00** – Evening gathering at the recreational meadow

The evening programme includes an **outdoor dinner** (buffet-style, with hot dishes) and a **bonfire** in a relaxed, informal atmosphere.

**21:00 - 21:30** – End of the evening in Granica, return to Warsaw by buses

**Dress code:** casual outdoor clothing; warm layers are recommended.

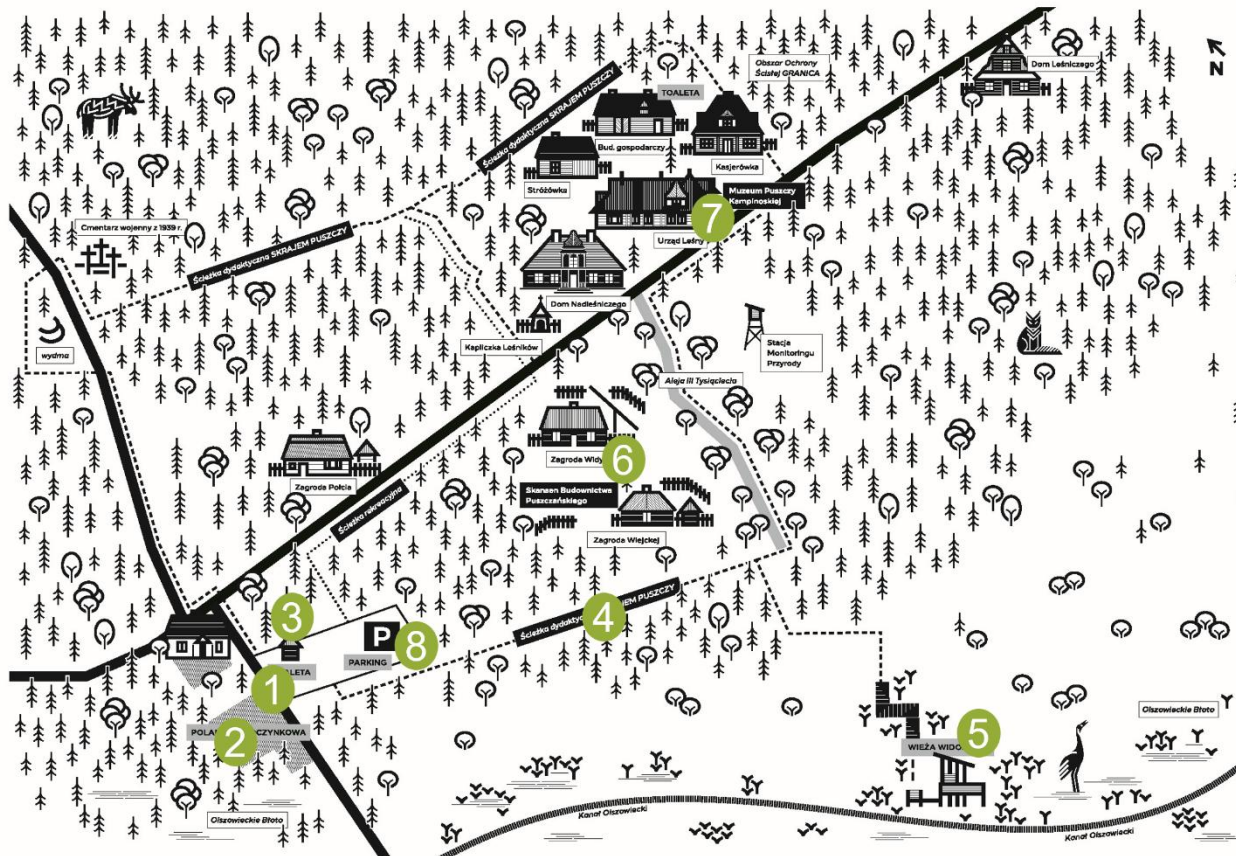
